Each year the White Rock Social Justice Film Society awards a bursary to a student in memory of the society's founding member, Jack McLachlan, who died on December 25, 2013.

Amount	\$500
Eligibility	A BC-based high school student
Submission	Submissions accepted March 1st to May 15th
Award	The winning submission is decided collectively by the directors. The award is announced at our Annual General Meeting in June ¹

Requirements

The White Rock Social Justice Film society exists to encourage engagement with issues of social justice through creative work such as film. Applicants are invited to submit a creative essay on the topic of **social justice**.

While traditional written essays (of 1000–1500 words) are welcomed, we also encourage applicants to interpret “essay” to mean any substantial creative work that addresses the topic of social justice in an insightful and motivating manner, including poems, songs, short film (no more than five minutes long), or other forms of media.
